

This is with reference to Pakistan Post Foundation's letter dated 30<sup>th</sup> November 2011 sent in response to TI Pakistan's letters dated 01<sup>st</sup> November 2011 on the above subject.

Pakistan Post Foundation has stated that "it is self supporting organization which earn funds through business for the welfare of the Postal Employees, therefore, it does not fall under the purview of the Public Procurement Rules 2004".

TI Pakistan would like to point out that the Pakistan Post Foundation is a registered trademark of Pakistan Post Office according to the Note (enclosed) given on <http://ep.gov.pk/termsfuse.asp>. It is also important to note that Pakistan Post Foundation is using a land line number (051- 9278377) and a fax number (051-9278378), which are allowed only for the public sector organizations. ✓


Transparency International Pakistan would also like to mention that the Pakistan Post Foundation is registered with the Federal Board of Revenue as M/S Pakistan Post Foundation and Pakistan Post Foundation Mail Motor Service under the same NTN 2293644-7.

It is therefore advised that being a federal procuring agency, the above tender may be re-invited under the Public Procurement Rules 2004 or it may be declared as mis-procurement under Rule 50.

TI Pakistan is for across the board application of the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Ordinance 2002 and the Public Procurement Rules 2004.
