Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 by PPO

Dear Sir,

The prequalification notice issued by Mr. Shahid Iqbal, Dy. Post Master General, Sukkur, for the Contractors for Repair, Extension and Contraction of PPO Building in Sukkur, published in Dawn dated 22 August 2009 in Daily Dawn (copy enclosed) is in violation of PPRA Rules.

It is mandatory on Pakistan Post Office to provide Prequalification Documents to applicants, which shall also include detailed evaluation criteria, is not being given to PPO on this Project.

These procedures, made mandatory are taken from the Transparent Procurement Procedures recommended by Transparency International Pakistan and prescribed by the National Accountability Bureau (NAB) in the National Accountability Strategy (NACS) 2002.

The prequalification documents shall includes all relevant information including the detailed evaluation criteria, bid award method, signing of Integrity Pact, rights of bidders for complain on evaluation report prior to award, declaration of Evaluation report before the award of Contract etc.

Transparency International Pakistan request Pakistan Post Office to make all its procurement Transparent, and in accordance with the requirements of Public Procurement Rules 2004.

Kindly also comply with the PPRA requirements under Rule No. 47 (quoted below) , that the Evaluation Reports and Contracts Agreement is to be made public, and that the

Evaluation Reports, Contracts Agreements and duly filled in NAB Evaluation Form (for more than Rs. 50 million Contracts) and PPRA Evaluation Form (for above Rs 10 million Contracts shall be sent to NAB

"47. **Public access and transparency.**- As soon as a contract has been awarded, the procuring agency shall make all documents related to the evaluation of the bid and award of contract public"

This particular procurement comes under Rule 50. Mis-procurement.-Any unauthorized breach of these rules shall amount to mis-procurement.
