Sub National Corruption Perception Survey (NCPS) 2010

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan (TI Pakistan), aims at building a coherent National Integrity System, to institutionalize efforts to curb corruption, and make our country Zero Tolerance against Corruption. **Rule of Law shall be supreme in Pakistan.** The ultimate goal of across the board implementation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 is to make corruption a "high risk" and "low return" undertaking.

TI Pakistan is conducting the fourth National Corruption Perception Survey, 2010, and will release the report in June 2010. A Survey on the performance of the implementation of Public Procurement Rules 2004 in all the Federal Government Procuring Agencies is included in the NCPS 2010. PPRA Rules, notifications and regulations stipulates that following information on all procurements shall have been available on the procurement agencies website as well as on the PPRA website also.

1. Evaluation results
2. Public Contracts of Works, Services & Goods Worth RS.50 Million or More.
3. Procurement Planning
4. Procurement Reports
5. Redressal Grievance Committees
6. Procurement Notice

As PPRA has been highly proactive since last two years, and has also directed procuring agencies to forward compliance reports for the year ending June 2009 vide its letter No. F. 1(2)Dir-(Leg)/PPRA/04 dated 30 June 2009. PPRA has managed to post these information on PPRA website.

TI Pakistan request for the list of names of procuring agencies who are providing the required information to PPRA for updating on PPRA website.

The Non Compliance Procuring Agencies will be declared in NCPS 2010 as Violators of PPRA Rules and Regulation.

We have noted that MES, DHA, Cantonment Board, Civil Aviation, Saperco, State Life Insurance Corporation, PNSC, NHIA, KPT, PIA, Gwadar Port, and many other procuring agencies are violators as their information (all six quoted above) are not available on your website.

We request PPRA to kindly provide the information to TI Pakistan, to reach us latest by 30th May 2010.
