Sub: Complaint on inviting Tenders for the Rs 10 Billion Development of Infrastructure facilities such as Road, Storm Water Drainage, Water Supply and Sewerage System in EIZ (Package-I, II, V & VI) only from M/S NLC and M/S FWO, and use of discriminatory specifications of GRP pipes, which may cause loss of Rs. 1.44 billion to the exchequer.

Transparency International Pakistan has received another complaint that PQA Director General P&D Division has invited Tenders for the Rs 10 Billion Development of Infrastructure facilities such as Road, Storm Water Drainage, Water Supply and Sewerage System in EIZ (Package-I, II, V & VI) only from M/S NLC and M/S FWO, and use of discriminatory specifications of GRP pipes, which may cause loss of Rs. 1.44 billion to the exchequer.

This is also to report that Chairman PQA has confirmed to TUP that open tenders will be invited, which was also confirmed in writing in TIP letter to QA dated 6th September 2012, which has not been denied by PQA till today.

TI-Pakistan requests the DG, (A&P), NAB to kindly look into these allegations, as Chairman PQA has gone on foreign tour and reportedly will be coming back on 4th October 2012.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
