Sub: Violation of Public Procurement Rules 2004, Secretary, Port Qasim Authority, Tender Notice for the appointment of Consultant for Repair Maintenance work of PQA Marine Structures – TI Letters dated 26th October 2011, 14th November 2011, 09th December 2011 and 14th December 2011, PPRA Letters dated 27th October 2011 & 15th November 2011 and PQA Letter dated 25th November 2011.

This is with reference to the series of letters sent to the Port Qasim Authority by Transparency International Pakistan on the above subject. The issue was also taken up by the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority with PQA through its letters, but no satisfactory response has been received from your office so far.

TI Pakistan has received information from the complainant stating that some works mentioned in the tender notice, advertised in September 2011, have already been done.

To verify the complainant's claim, Transparency International Pakistan requests Port Qasim Authority to kindly provide the following documents:

1. Copy of Agreement (containing scope of work and payable amount) between PQA and EA.
2. Copy of Final Report of Assessment of Marine Structures by EA.
3. Copy of Tender Documents of new Assessment work.

TI Pakistan would also like to know about the utilization of EA's services by PQA after submission of the Final Report of Assessment of Marine Structures.
