Subject: Violation of PPRA Ordinance and Public Procurement Rules 2014 in Inviting Tender of Four Tugs of 75 tons -85 tons Bollard Pull, and also debarring China, Jeopardizing the Chinese Investment of US \$ 35 B in Pakistan.

Dear Sir,

TI-Pakistan refers to its letters dated 19-7-2014 on complaint regarding violation of PPRA Ordinance and Public Procurement Rules 2014 in inviting tender of two giant tugs of 75 tons -85 tons bollard pull, and also debarring China, jeopardizing the Chinese investment of US \$ 35 B in Pakistan. However no reply has been received till date.

Transparency International Pakistan, vide its above mentioned letter, has identified various violations of PQA in this procurement.

The Chairman PQA is again requested to examine the complaint, and if found correct, amend the tender documents to comply with PPRA requirements, and invite the tender on Single Stage one Envelop Procedure, and allow China and manufacturers of all other countries, excluding those with which govt. has banned trade, and issue addendum accordingly.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
