1. Urgency granted.
2. It is inter alia contended by the learned counsel for the plaintiff that the defendant Nos.1 and 2 are the employees of defendant No.3. On 14.5.2013 a news report was published in the newspaper 'The Express Tribune', which was also circulated on the website. In this news item it has been stated that the Transparency International Pakistan highlighted serious allegations of insider trading against JSBL and JS Group. In the 3rd paragraph it was also mentioned that SECP has confirmed that the allegations against the plaintiff are correct and criminal case was also filed in the court of law in April, 2013. Learned counsel submits that after publication of this news item, notice was given to 'The Express Tribune', who published clarification on 16.5.2013. Learned counsel also pointed out letter of SECP (copy of which is available at page-47 of the court file) in which the SECP has confirmed that they have no adverse findings against JS Bank. Learned counsel further pointed out a press clipping of Daily Ummat dated 18.5.2013 (copy of which is available at page-49 of the court file), according to him it was also

originated by the defendant No.1. Learned counsel argued that due to such type of allegations the defendants have tarnished and disparaged the good name and image of the plaintiff and also committed trade libel. Issue notice to the defendants for 28.5.2013. Meanwhile, the defendants are restrained from contributing or circulating any libelous or false material against the plaintiff.

2. Learned counsel for the plaintiff contended that defendant No. 2 claims to be the advisor of defendant No. 3 who is anticorruption watchdog. Per learned counsel defendant No. 2 is using the platform of defendant No. 3 for the purpose of maligning and damaging the reputation of the plaintiff. Mr. Khalid Jawed Khan, learned counsel for plaintiff further contended that defendant No. 2 is not within his rights to use the platform for maligning and damaging the reputation of the plaintiff. Under circumstances let notice be issued to the defendants for 12.6.2013, till then defendant No. 2 is restrained from misusing the platform/forum of defendant No. 3 for damaging the reputation of the plaintiff and/or for promoting the personal agenda of the business opponents/rivals.
