Transparency International Pakistan refers to its letter dated 4-7-2014 of SLIC complaint against SBP (**Annex-A**).

Transparency International Pakistan had forwarded a complaint in which State Bank of Pakistan has not followed the PPRA rule in letter and spirit and has declared State Life Insurance as non-responsive, which is the biggest and only AAA Insurance Company in Pakistan, and has life fund reserves of over Rs300 billion assets.

The Governor is requested to kindly examine above violations of SBP, and discharge the tender, which should be re-invited, and also action should be taken against all those officers involved in this collusive practice of inserting the illegal condition in the tender documents.
