Subject: Violations of SLIC

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has sent a letter on 28 April 2010, objecting on prequalification procedure for Outdoor Advertising Firm Selection, but no response as yet has been given. Similarly on 29 August 2009 TIP sent a complaint on permanent appointment of NESPAC's general consultant of SLIC, and PPRA also asked on SLIC 1 September 2009 to clarify the objection of TIP, and the response is also awaited.

We would like to remind that SLIC and TIP has signed an MOU on 19th April 2010, and TIP is waiting for the nomination from SLIC of the Committee members, so that SLIC Procurement Manual meetings could begin. We would also like to inform the SLIC is not abiding with following PPRA mandatory requirements, which may become a very embarrassing situation for SLIC.

PPRA Rules, notifications and regulations stipulates that following information on all procurements shall have been available on the procurement agencies website as well as on the PPRA website also.

1. Evaluation results
2. Public Contracts of Works, Services & Goods Worth RS.50 Million or More.
3. Procurement Planning
4. Procurement Reports
5. Redressal Grievance Committees
6. Procurement Notice

We request for urgent action on above quoted serious violations being committed by SLIC.
