Subject: OBSERVATIONS BY TRANSPARENCY INTERNATIONAL PAKISTAN ON THE TENDER "RFP FOR FRONT END COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE FOR DMC (EAST) KARACHI"

With reference to telephonic discussion on 4th January 2016 by Syed Adil Gilani with the undersigned and Mr. Roshan Ali Shaikh, Managing Director on the subject referred above, wherein concern was shown on opening of only one bid, it is clarified that:

- All proceedings of the tender for Front End Collection and Disposal of Municipal Solid Waste for DMC (East), Karachi have been carried out according to the procedure prescribed in Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013).
- Two (02) Bids were received in response to International NIT, for subject job, under Rule 46 (2) of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013) i.e. Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure.
- Following Technical Sub-committee was constituted for Technical evaluation of the bids:
 - o Engr. Shafiq Ur Rehman - Director (Front End Collection), SSWMB
 - o Engr. Najeeb Ahmed - Director (Solid Waste Mgt.), KMC
 - o Engr. Iqbal Ahmed - Sr. Director (Sanitation), DMC - East
- The Technical Bids were opened on 26th October 2015 and sent to Technical Sub-committee for Technical Evaluation as required under Sub-rule 2(e) Rule 46 (2) of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013).
- The Technical Committee carried out Technical Evaluation of the Bids as per criteria set in RFP document and declared only one bid submitted by M/S Changyi Kanjhie Sanitation Engineering Company Limited as Qualified / Technically Responsive.
- The Financial Proposal of only Technical Qualified Bid i.e. M/S Changyi Kanjhie Sanitation Engineering Company Limited were opened on 4th January 2016 as prescribed under Sub-rule 2(g) Rule 46 (2) of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013).



- The Financial Proposal of the other bid found technically non-responsive was not opened due to limitation imposed under Sub-rule 2(h) Rule 46 (2) of Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013) reproduced below:
 - o (h) financial proposal of bids found technically non-responsive shall be returned un-opened to the respective bidder;

- Attention is also invited to Rule 48 of ibid Rules (reproduced below):

"Even when only one bid is submitted, the bidding process may be considered valid, if the bid was advertised in accordance with rules, and prices are comparable to the prices or rates awarded contract or the market prices"

- Above position clearly depicts that whole process is being carried out according to Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013) and no deviations whatsoever have been made.

Let me take this opportunity to reiterate that Sindh Solid Waste Management Board (SSWMB) has signed the Memorandum of Understanding with Transparency International with full sincerity to ensure transparency in all its ~~our~~ procurement processes by following the procedure prescribed under Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2013) – and we remain determined to observe it in true letter and spirit.
