

after completing hydraulic model study and sub-soil investigation works including excavation of exploratory adits.

It is further submitted that Private Power Infrastructure Board (PPIB), Ministry of Water & Power issued LOI on 15.01.2005 in favour of Wic China International Water and Electric Corporation (CWE) for updation of feasibility study prepared by WAPDA Consultants mentioned above. WAPDA handed over the feasibility report to PPIB on the instruction of Ministry of Water & Power. It is informed that WAPDA was not involved in issuance of LOI to CWE.

Further it is suggested that if any information regarding allocation of project to CWE without Competitive Bidding is required that may be asked from PPIB, Ministry of Water & Power, Islamabad.
